*DDA stands for District Determined Assessment. These are district level created exams that will cover the standards for the course. The standards for each course can be found on the website www.CPALMS.org.

*EOQ stands for End of Quarter exams. An exam created by the district curriculum specialists based on the pacing guide for each quarter. These can also be referred to as DFA.

*Geometry EOC – This is the State End of Course exam for Geometry. This test is created by the state to measure mastery of the standards. Passing this test is one requirement of a “scholar” designation on the student’s diploma.
