- Students who complete at least 50% of their suggested course before the first day of school • will receive extra credit in their 1st quarter grade for math in 2015-2016.

How do I log in to Study Island?

- Go to www.studyisland.com and enter your username and password.
- Username: 55s###### (fill in your 6 digit SJCSD Student ID) •
- Password: First Initial + Last Initial + MMDDYYYY of birth •
- For example, if your name is Jane Doe and your student ID is 123456 and your date of • birth is January 1, 2000 you would have a username of 55s123456 and a password of JD01012000.

Fast Facts:

- Each subject is made up of topics, each of which corresponds to a specific state standard.
- Each topic contains lessons, practice questions and explanations.
- Most topics are accompanied by a lesson which includes some brief information about the material covered by the questions in the topic.
