What is Study Island?

- Study Island is a free online program to help students review and master the standards specific to his or her grade level in Math, English, Social Studies and Science!
- In addition, Study Island offers College Readiness programs including ACT and SAT Prep, AP Exam review, College Admissions tips and more!

What should I do in Study Island?

- The SAHS Math department recommends students use this program to review and prepare for the next level of math. Students should complete the program listed below beside the math course they will be taking for the 2015-2016 school year.
- *Students who complete at least 50% of their suggested course before the first day of school will receive extra credit in their 1st quarter grade for math in 2015-2016.*

How do I log in to Study Island?

- Go to www.studyisland.com and enter your username and password.
- Username: 55s##### (fill in your 6 digit SJCS D Student ID)
- Password: First Initial + Last Initial + MMDDYYYY of birth
- For example, if your name is Jane Doe and your student ID is 123456 and your date of birth is January 1, 2000 you would have a username of 55s123456 and a password of JD01012000.

Fast Facts:

- Each subject is made up of topics, each of which corresponds to a specific state standard.
- Each topic contains lessons, practice questions and explanations.
- Most topics are accompanied by a lesson which includes some brief information about the material covered by the questions in the topic.
- You can also incorporate games into your studies while on Study Island
