<u>Old Business</u>

1. Auction

- Dena has the list of businesses and people who donated last year. Jessica will send out the first round of letters to those on the list.
- Eileen asked how we should do the food this year. We were going to try to do a Taste of St. Augustine last year but were short on time so it was asked if we wanted to try it this year or to keep it simple like last year. It was decided to keep it simple.

2. Bank Account

3. Non-Profit Status

• The Booster Club is officially a 501c3. We now need to file a form with the State that will allow the club to be recognized as tax exempt. Also need to check with the Dept. of Agriculture to see if we need to do anything to be allowed to collect donations

4. Marketing Materials

- The AICE Program is still looking into acquiring marketing materials, ie. display boards, stationery, folders, etc.
- It was decided that the stationery should have both the school's emblem and the Cambridge AICE emblem on the top – one in each of the upper corners of the paper. In between will be the organization's name & address. Will keep 2 master copies: 1 for the Booster club with its info and one for the AICE program with its info. Jessica will go to the UPS store to get the letterhead printed.

New Business
