## AICE Program Curriculum Requirements

The <u>AICE Curriculum</u> requires students to successfully \*\*<u>complete</u> a minimum of <u>seven</u> AICE level courses <u>and</u> the corresponding examinations, with at least one course and exam from each of three subject groupings AND the "Core".

\*\*<u>Complete</u> = 1) pass the course & 2) "sit for"/take the Cambridge exam (passing the exam is not required for high school graduation.

\*AICE Psychology & AICE P.E. count in either the Math/Sci. or Humanities categories of AICE courses (not BOTH). <u>AICE Psychology & AICE Sport & P.E.</u> count as <u>elective</u> credits on the high school transcript, <u>not</u> as high school math or science credits, but both are considered academic electives to colleges.

## AICE Diploma Award (earned from/awarded by Cambridge – not SAHS):

To be on track toward completion of the <u>AICE Diploma Award</u>, students must <u>pass</u> a minimum of seven AICE exams, with at least one exam from each of the three subject groupings <u>AND</u> the "Core". Students who <u>pass</u> the required seven exams within a 25-month period will earn the <u>AICE Diploma Award</u> from Cambridge International Examinations <u>(not to be confused with your SAHS High School Diploma)</u>. \*Passing scores on these exams can count in one of the two categories towards the award, not both.
