Cambridge Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) Curriculum

SAHS was the second school in the U.S. to offer the Cambridge AICE program in 1997. This program offers a rigorous international curriculum and examination system which emphasizes the value of broad and balanced study for academically advanced students. AICE courses are college level, equivalent to International GCE A and AS level courses. Students earn college credit for passing scores on the Cambridge examination at the end of each course. Dual Enrollment

The Dual Enrollment program allows admitted students to complete a full 60 credits of dual enrollment coursework, culminating in earning both a standard high school diploma as well as an Associate of Arts (AA) Degree upon the completion of four years of high school.

St. Johns County Academy of Future Teachers

This academy explores careers in Education using service learning, cutting-edge technology, and full year internships. Fostering the next generation of educators, the program focuses on developing student leaders who will be the next caring contributors to the children of the future.

St. Johns County Aerospace Academy

Partnered with Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, the Aerospace Academy offers an introduction to STEM careers in Aviation and Aerospace.

- Embry Riddle University expanded the number of Dual Enrollment courses offered, flying drones weekly and flight simulators daily.

- In 2020, 28 students received certification in Unmanned Aircraft Safety (UAS) Level 1.
- The Aerospace club meets weekly
- Five junior students are beginning year one of the Northrop Grumman HIP Mentorship program. Three senior students are moving on to year two of the program, completing hands on projects and gaining experience from professionals in the industry.

Academy of Law and Homeland Security

This program introduces students to the various academic and career opportunities in Law, Law Enforcement, and other Homeland Security related fields.

- Steadily growing, ALHS recently added Code Enforcement and Crime Scene Tech classes.
- Continuing Police Service Aide, Private Security Guard, and 911 Telecommunicator.
- Five areas of entry level positions available to our graduates. ALHS has two full-time instructors with more than 48 years of combined experience.
- The students are all part of our co-curricular club, The Florida Public Service Association. This organization meets after school on Wednesdays and Saturdays and gives the students exposure to the hands-on training for this career path.
- Our training includes defensive tactics, fingerprinting, traffic stops, and report writing to name a few. Students are currently training to compete in the North Regional Competition in November.
- Last year the Academy of Law and Homeland Security brought home the “Top Chapter” for the state of Florida at the State Leadership Conference in March of 2021.

St. Johns County Center for the Arts (SJCCA)

SJCCA provides artistically gifted students with a pre-professional program of study designed to develop their unique talents in the performing and visual arts. SJCCA students must audition before being accepted into the Academy. The following programs are offered in SJCCA: Band, Ceramics, Chorus, Dance, Digital Art, Drawing and Painting, Guitar, Drama, Musical Theatre, and Piano.
