- When and Where? Tuesday, March 26, 2024, from 9:20am-1:30pm, during the school day. Add it to your calendar now. This will help you plan your Spring testing opportunities.
- Who? 11th grade students in English 3/AICE Lit 1/Amer Lit Honors for the first time: You are automatically signed up for the test at no cost! Your test room will be posted in the school and sent via Schoology.
- Why? ACT can give you a concordant score for the Algebra 1/Geometry EOC (score of 16+), and/or FSA ELA Writing/Reading (average score of 18 on the Reading and English subtests). It also gives students more opportunities for college applications and scholarships.

- What? The test is 3 hours (plus breaks). This test includes 4 sections: Reading, English, Science, and Math with a calculator (must bring your own approved calculator no cell phones/smart watches).
- Make an account at ACT.org now, and take a practice test to prepare.
