



ACT College Reported for Grade 11



- **When and Where?** Tuesday, February 25, 2025, from 9:20am-1:30pm, during the school day. Add it to your calendar now. This will help you plan your Spring testing opportunities.
- **Who?** 11th grade students in English 3/AICE Lit 1/Amer Lit Honors/AICE GP for the first time: You are automatically signed up for the test at no cost! Your test room will be posted in the front of the media center.
- **Why?** ACT can give you a concordant score for the Algebra 1/Geometry EOC (score of 16+), and/or FSA ELA Writing/Reading (average score of 18 on the Reading and English subtests). It also gives students more opportunities for college applications and scholarships.
- **What?** The test is 3 hours (plus breaks). This test includes 4 sections: Reading, English, Science, and Math with a calculator (**must bring your own approved calculator - no cell phones/smart watches**). Bring Lunch/Snacks/Water bottles and Materials, including pencils & calculators, will need to be provided by the student:
