Dear Parents/Guardians:

The St. Johns County School District's high schools will be administering the PSAT/NMQST test free of charge to all **10th grade students\*** (in Eng 2 for the first time), on October 22, 2025.

Listed below are some reasons why your student should consider taking the PSAT/NMQST:

- PSAT math score can be used as a concordant score for the Algebra 1 EOC
- Grade 10 pre-college testing provides a basis to increase college participation.
- The PSAT is an indicator for performance on the SAT.
- PSAT includes verbal, mathematics, and writing components; it is used as a diagnostic tool to measure strengths and weaknesses for both students and curriculum.
- The PSAT helps assess academic skills necessary for college-level work.

Any 10th grade parent that does not wish for their student to take the PSAT/NMQST test on October 23<sup>rd</sup> must sign this letter and have the student return it to Mrs. Jasper in the Media Center prior to September 12<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Gr. 10 students who do not return this form by 9/12/25 will take the PSAT/NMQST on 10/22/25 during school hours.
