The St. Johns County School District's high schools will be administering the PSAT/NMQST test free of charge to all **10th grade students*** (in Eng 2 for the first time), on October 22, 2025.

Listed below are some reasons why your student should consider taking the PSAT/NMQST:

- **PSAT math score can be used as a concordant score for the Algebra 1 EOC**
- Grade 10 pre-college testing provides a basis to increase college participation.
- The PSAT is an indicator for performance on the SAT.
- PSAT includes verbal, mathematics, and writing components; it is used as a diagnostic tool to measure strengths and weaknesses for both students and curriculum.
- The PSAT helps assess academic skills necessary for college-level work.

Any 10th grade parent that does not wish for their student to take the PSAT/NMQST test on October 23rd must sign this letter and have the student return it to Mrs. Jasper in the Media Center prior to September 12th, 2025. Gr. 10 students who do not return this form by 9/12/25 will take the PSAT/NMQST on 10/22/25 during school hours.
