Dear Parents/Guardians:

The St. Johns County School District's high schools will be administering the PSAT/NMQST test to all 10th grade students (in Eng 2 for the first time), free of charge, on October 22, 2025. All students in 9th and 11th grades can take the PSAT; however, they must pay a fee of \$22.00 by 9/14/2025, in order to register to test.

Although the test is geared toward 10th graders, there are many other reasons students in other grades would want to consider taking the test. Listed below are some reasons why your student should consider taking the PSAT/NMQST:

- PSAT math score can be used as a concordant score for the Algebra 1 EOC
- Grade 10 pre-college testing provides a basis to increase college participation.
- The PSAT is an indicator for performance on the SAT.
- PSAT includes verbal, mathematics, and writing components; it is used as a diagnostic tool to measure strengths and weaknesses for both students and curriculum.
- The PSAT helps assess academic skills necessary for collegelevel work.



Any 9th or 11th grade parent that that wants your student to take the PSAT/NMQST test on October 22nd must sign this letter and have the student return it to Mrs. Jasper in the Media Center with payment of \$22 made on Schoolpay at SchoolPay - Checkout, no later than Sunday, September 14, 2025. The form alone does not hold your space.

There are NO exceptions to this deadline as the exam is now computer-based and College Board has a hard deadline for schools to register.
