PSAT-NMSQT Testing

PSAT-NMSQT TESTING INFORMATION 2025

Deadline for 9th & 11th to register is Sunday, September 14, 2025. There are NO exceptions to this deadline as the exam is now computer-based and College Board has a hard deadline for schools to register.

Please see below for specifics on 9th, 10th, and 11th grade test date specifics.

St. Augustine High School will administer the **PSAT/NMSQT** (Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test – National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test) to students in **October 2025** (**Exact date to be determined**). The purpose of the test is to give all students an opportunity to experience taking a college readiness test and identify students who might benefit from advanced coursework. The PSAT is also the exam that is used for 11th graders to qualify for the National Merit Scholars Program. **Additionally, a score of 430 on the PSAT Math qualifies as a concordant score for the Algebra I EOC.**

There is no need to register 10th grade students, they will receive their test at no cost, through state funding.

9th and 11thgraders wishing to take the test:

In order to test, you must register online. Please click here to register and pay: <u>School Pay-PSAT</u> (grade 9,11, and homeschool students). The last day to pay & register will be 11:59 pm on September 14, 2025. There is NO possibility of testing if payment is not received by this date. PSAT/NMSQT scores are typically available online 4–6 weeks after the test administration.

Students with a IEP or 504 Plan:

Please be sure to complete the accommodation consent request and return to Ms. Jasper, in the media center, by **August 22, 2025**. This must be processed by this time for College Board to approve your school-based accommodations. Requests after this date will not be processed and students will test without school-based accommodations. **Consent Form**

If you have already applied for accommodations with College Board, you do not need to apply again, you retain the accommodations until one year after graduation date. However, if your accommodations change, it is **YOUR** responsibility to complete a new form and resubmit it in plenty of time.

More information will be sent out closer to the date of the test, including a digital copy of the Official Student Guide to the PSAT/ NMSQT®. This guide contains valuable information as well as a full-length practice test with answer keys.
