Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

As we move toward the end of the year and prepare for 2021-2022, we would like to take an opportunity to address student parking. **Next year, we will have 340 parking spots available to students**. This includes an addition of **60 spots** from this school year. We have utilized every possible location on campus to maximize student parking opportunities. We intend to provide a fair and unbiased system for students to receive their parking spots, therefore we have implemented the **NEW PROCESS detailed below.**

Please read all the following information carefully. Follow all procedures and pay attention to deadlines. Please note that the purpose for the process below is to secure a parking spot for the 2021-2022 school year. Further information regarding Senior/Junior lots (including spot painting) will come out once applicants have been selected.

ELIGIBILITY: Must be a Senior or Junior. No sophomores, **NO EXCEPTIONS**. Must have a valid Florida operator's driver license issued before September 1, 2021. **Additionally, you must have over a 2.0 unweighted GPA, NO Level 3/4 suspensions, and less than 15 Unexcused absences for the current school year.**

COST: \$85.00 (General parking)/\$150.00 (Senior reserved)

PRIDRITY PARKING RECIPIENTS: The top 50 Class of 2022 students (determined by weighted GPA from the end of this past fall semester) will have the opportunity to purchase a parking spot first. These students will be notified individually and will need to submit paperwork no later than Friday, May 14.

LOTTERY PARKING RECIPIENTS: The remaining parking spots will be decided via lottery. Students will have to register for the lottery online anytime between Monday, May 10 and Friday, May 14 by 4:30pm. Look for SAHS Parking Lottery link on the front of the SAHS website or **CLICK HERE>>** to enter online. *Please note that ANY false or misleading information entered in said form will lead to IMMEDIATE REMOVAL from the Parking Lottery.

A computer will randomly draw names and you will be notified via email and text if you have been selected. **The list will also be posted in the cafeteria on Thursday, May 20**. The number of spots available will be affected by the total number of spots purchased by top 50 Class of 2022 students.

LOTTERY SCORING: Students who enter the lottery will be randomly assigned a number between 1.00 and 0.00 via a computer program.

- BONUS ADDENDS: Students will get an additional 0.1 point bonus to their random score for EACH of the following factors (if they apply):
 - Senior Class Member
 - o 4.0 or Higher Weighted GPA
 - Member of a SAHS Academy Program (Aerospace Academy, SJCCA, Academy of Future Teachers, & Academy of Law and Homeland Security)
 - o **School-based Activity Participation** (Arts, Clubs, Sports, I.E.)
 - o Off Campus Dual Enrollment at St Johns River State College
 - o Modified Schedule (including off-campus Executive Internship)

STUDENTS SELECTED: Students who were fortunate enough to be selected should turn in this completed form and their \$85 check (even if they would like a Senior preferred parking spot), made out to SAHS, during their lunch in the cafeteria between Monday, May 24 and Thursday, May 27. (If you don't do this you **WILL NOT** get a parking pass) A friend may turn it in for you.

*Please note that selected Seniors will receive more information about how to sign up for a reserved spot following this initial process.

DISTRIBUTION: Your hanging parking tag will be handed out in August. Lists of names and parking spots will be posted all around campus so you can locate your newly assigned spot.
