DISCIPLINE

PROGRESSION

LEVEL 1 OFFENSES

BEFORE REFERRAL

1. Redirection of Behavior
2. Parent/Guardian Contact (Phone/Email)
3. Teacher Consequence
4. Dean Referral in TAC

LEVEL 2 OFFENSES



TARDINESS

-Student is not in the classroom prior to the tardy bell ringing AFTER a teacher has closed the door.

INSUBORDINATION

-Failure or refusal to follow directions of school staff, school rules, classroom rules, or behavioral contracts. may be escalated to Level 2 or 3 based on severity.

DRESS CODE

-Student wears something not aligned to SJCS D dress code. I.E. Hats, hoods, clothes of a revealing nature or inappropriate language.

CLASSROOM DISRUPTION

-Saying or doing something that keeps the teacher from teaching or other students from learning. May be Level 2 based on severity.

CHEATING

-Unauthorized use of notes or other forms of assistance. Claiming another's work as their own. 0% for work received.

PROFANITY/ VERBAL ALTERCATION

-Student uses profanity directed towards an adult or student with the intent to disrespect, degrade, or embarrass the victim.

SKIPPING CLASS

-Student fails to attend class without a note from a parent/guardian or doctor. This includes leaving the classroom of school campus without permission. May be level 3 based on severity.

UNAUTHORIZED TECHNOLOGY USE

-Student uses cell phone or other form of technology in a classroom without permission or inappropriately. May be Level 3 based on severity and intent.

PROGRESSIVE DISCIPLINE FOR LEVEL 1

- Step 1: Dean Conference
- Step 2: Lunch Detention (1)
- Step 3: Lunch Detention (2)
- Step 4: Closed Campus Procedure
- Step 5: Parent/Guardian Phone/Online Conference
- Step 6: Lunch Detail (1)
- Step 7: Lunch Detail (2)
- Step 8: In School Suspension (1)
- Step 9: In School Suspension (2)

10+ Incidents will result in before/after school detention.

PROGRESSIVE DISCIPLINE FOR LEVEL 2

- Step 1: In School Suspension (1)*
- Step 2: In School Suspension (1)/Guardian Conference*
- Step 3: Out of school suspension (1)*
- Step 4: Out of school suspension (1)*

7+ Potential Gaines Placement for Requested Offenses

*Dependent on Offense / All steps can be skipped depending on magnitude of offense.

Any Senior that commits a Level 4 offense will not be allowed to participate in the Graduation Commencement Ceremony. This is non-negotiable for the second semester. If a student commits a Level 4 offense in the first semester, they will be immediately deemed ineligible to participate in commencement.
