

How should I prepare for my registration appointment?

Questions a school counselor might ask a student at their registration appointment:	How a student can prepare before their registration appointment:
What do you want to do after high school?	<i>University, state college, technical school, military, work force?</i>
What are your career interests? What do you plan to study in college?	<i>Explore careers through elective classes, summer internships, career interest inventories, etc. Research education and training requirements. Choose high school courses that match your interest.</i>
Where do you want to go to college?	<i>Visit colleges. Speak to admissions representatives. Ask questions about what the institution is looking for in an applicant. Research required courses for your intended program of study.</i>
What are the admissions criteria for your school of choice?	<i>Know the average test scores, average GPA, high school courses, world language requirement, etc.</i>
Are you planning on taking a course(s) online?	<i>Students must declare intent to take courses virtually by the last day of school. Students may not drop a class to take the same course online once they are enrolled in the course.</i>
Do you need Credit/Grade Recovery? (D or F only in an academic course)	<i>Courses can be retaken via FLVS, SJVS or Edmentum. See your school counselor with any questions.</i>
Are you an athlete? If so, do your classes meet NCAA requirements? Please note, NCAA does not recognize Edmentum courses.	<i>Research the requirements for NCAA. Student athletes must register with the NCAA eligibility center.</i>
Do you plan on applying for dual enrollment? Which class(es) would you take? Would you prefer am or pm modified periods?	<i>Think about how dual enrollment would impact your SAHS schedule. See your school counselor with any questions.</i>
Are you requesting to modify a class period(s)? (11 th or 12 th gr only) Would you prefer am or pm modified periods?	<i>Are you meeting graduation requirements? Consider your commitments – academic rigor, extracurricular activities, work. Please note, this is a request and not guaranteed.</i>
Do you have a job? (11 th or 12 th gr only)	<i>Consider Executive Internship as a course option.</i>
