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Field Study Criteria to ATTEND

-  **Students are encouraged to maintain strong attendance!**
To stay eligible for special events and opportunities, students should **avoid being placed on the truancy list** by attending school regularly and arriving on time.
 -  **Keep up your grades!**
To stay eligible for field studies and special events, students should **maintain a C or higher in all current classes**. Make sure your gradebook reflects your hard work and academic success!
 -  **Show Positive Behavior!**
Students demonstrate readiness for special events by:
 - Maintaining **no more than 2 days of In-School Suspension (ISS)**
 - Maintaining **no more than 2 days of Out-of-School Suspension (OSS)** or a **combined total of 2 days ISS/OSS**
 - Having **no Level 3 discipline offenses** in the current semester
 - Having **no Level 4 discipline offenses** during the current school year
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AI Generated Images

- Any unauthorized AI generated images of students/staff may lead to an OSS and a referral to GAINES.



Discriminatory Language

- The SJCSO defines discriminatory language as abusive or threatening speech that is directed at an individual or group that expresses prejudice/hate against a particular group through verbal or written communication, material, electronic images, text, or similar behavior.
 - Consequence = OSS
 - Remember, you cannot take back the things you say!

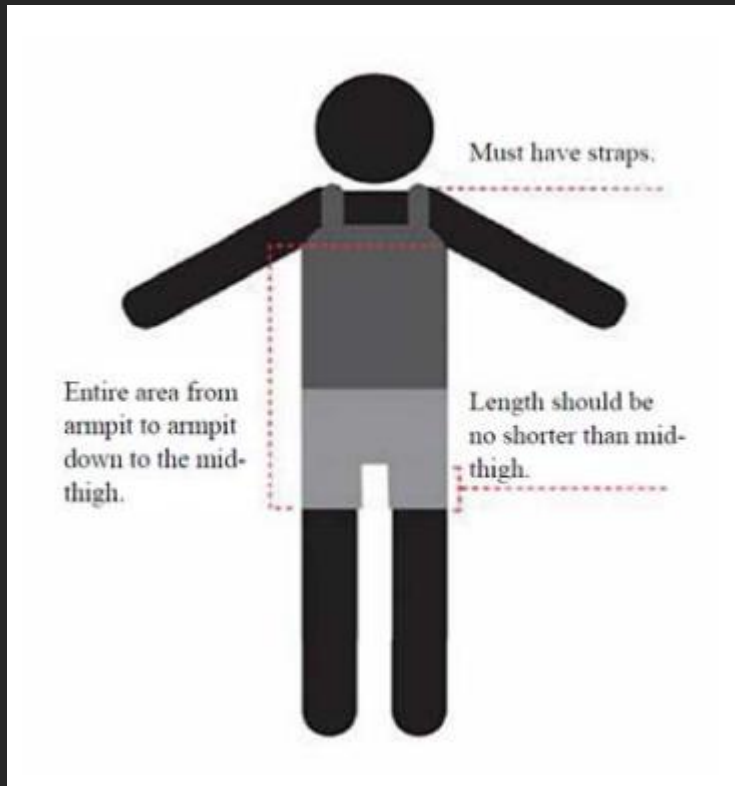


EARBUDS

DRESS CODE



- Reminders:
 - Armpit to Armpit
 - Shirts must have 2 straps
 - Shorts – midhigh length
 - Stomachs are not to be seen (see picture for example)
 - No head coverings
 - No Undergarments showing

When looking in the mirror, ask yourself, “Will I get dress coded for this?” If you have to question it, then don’t wear it!

Leaving Campus

- You may only leave campus early only if you submit and receive an early check out slip and sign out through the front office.
- SAHS is a single point of entry school. You may only enter/exit the building through the front office during school hours.

If you see chains on the doors, don't touch!

Modified Schedules/Executive Internship

- May only be on campus during your scheduled time.
 - Must check in/check out through the cart located in the front office lobby.
 - Remember, this is a privilege and can be taken away.
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Possession

- Possession of any illegal contraband may result in OSS.
- It is the student's responsibility for any contraband on their possession.
 - *This includes backpacks, lockers, vehicles.*



THINGS TO REMEMBER TO HELP YOU SWARM!!!

- Students who impede our ability to break up a fight
 - No Recording
 - No Loitering
 - No moving toward a fight.
 - No standing around a fight.
 - No Taking Joy out of classmates fighting each other.
 - Failure to SWARM may result in OSS.
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PARKING

- Reminders:
 - Do not park in other students parking spots.
 - Seek out Mr. Parkey (Parking Lot attendant) for any issues.
 - If someone parks in your spot, please report it. Do not park in any other spot.
 - If you report to early morning practices, please do not park in a staff members spot. They get to campus very early and need their space.
 - Parking lot violations may result in loss of privilege/tow.

Additional Consequences for Drivers

4 Tardies to 1st period of the day –

Counseled by Dean

5 Tardies to 1st period of the day –

Loss of parking tag for 5 days

6 Tardies to 1st period of the day –

Loss of parking tag for 10 days

7 tardies to 1st period of the day –

Loss of parking tag for 15 days.

Bus Infraction

- Riding bus is a privilege
- Any violation of procedures will result in loss of privilege to include suspension and possible removal from the bus for the year.
